Save the Children works with boys and girls, no matter what country they come from, no matter what race they are or where they come from, and no matter what their religion.

PEOPLE SHOULD NEVER HURT CHILDREN.

Unfortunately some people do hurt children by hitting them, sexually abusing them, shouting at them or not caring for them.

SAVE THE CHILDREN TRIES TO STOP PEOPLE HURTING CHILDREN.

If someone hurts you during a Save the Children activity, please tell a Save the Children worker. Or if you see a person hurting someone else during a Save the Children activity, please tell a Save the Children worker. The Save the Children worker will listen to you and help you.

IT IS NOT YOUR FAULT IF SOMEONE HURTS YOU.

If someone hurts you or if you see someone hurting another child, please tell a Save the Children worker what has happened. It is the worker's job to listen to you, to help you, and to decide what to do next.
